

Much is happening with the revitalization project. Mark and Abby Anderson will arrive in Egbe on April 30th and begin preparations for teams of volunteers scheduled to begin arriving in early June. A construction survey by a Nigerian company is in process and a cargo container is scheduled to arrive in Lagos from the US on April 4th. This container contains construction equipment and items for the Andersons. Please pray that negotiations to have the container released through customs will go smoothly.
