We are excited to share that in about a month we will be moving to Kijabe, Kenya to serve for a year. As many of you know, we've been seeking direction for the past four months. This has not been an easy process, but God has taken us through it and taught us some valuable lessons. Thank you for your prayers, encouragement, and sticking with us. We could not have made it through this period without you. We look forward to serving in Kijabe with your continued support and prayers.

Tim will be teaching at Moffat Bible College (www.moffatbiblecollege.org) and Maureen will be serving at Kijabe Hospital (www.kijabehospital.org). Moffat was founded in 1929 and Kijabe Hospital in 1915 - both by AIM (www.aimint.org) but are now owned and operated by the African Inland Church. **Please pray for us as we find our niche, adjust to these positions, and that Luke and Kate adapt and adjust to their new environment.**

The next month will be spent packing, planning, and saying good-byes! **Please pray that we can keep focus, stay calm, and enjoy time with family and friends.** The term at Moffat begins late August and we'd like to have a few weeks to get adjusted.

We do need additional monthly financial support - we are short almost \$2000/month. With the shift from Nigeria to Kenya, we lost one major supporter who is specifically supporting work in Egbe, Nigeria. However, SIM has cleared us to depart based on funds we have on hand. If you've considered supporting us in the past, now is the time to start. If you promised to give and have not started, please be sure to start in August. We simply ask that you give as God leads you and trust that what we need will be provided. A bit about Kenya:

Kenya has a population of just over 28 million and is roughly the size of France. There are over 58 languages spoken, although English and Swahili are the official languages. While Christianity has a strong presence in Kenya, there are roughly 24 "unreached" people groups, most following Islam or some traditional religion. Evangelical Christians comprise roughly 10% of the population.

Medical mission work provides an open door to minister the love and compassion of Jesus Christ while caring for the suffering. There is one physician for every 5,999 people. The average life expectancy is just over 50. 46% of the total population is under the age of 15, so training the next generation is crucial. Malnutrition and HIV/AIDS greatly impact the region. **Through medicine and discipleship, we can help make a difference through Christ. Please make this your prayer for us!**
